



CLEARWATER

Clearwater's origins trace back to 1528 when Spanish explorer Panfilo de Narvaez first landed on its shores, 37 years before the establishment of St. Augustine. De Narvaez's expedition marked one of the earliest European encounters with the area, which was inhabited by a large tribe of Native Americans. Despite initial resistance, the Indian communities were gradually displaced, only to see their territory reclaimed during the Seminole Wars from 1835 to 1842.

Among the first permanent settlers was Dr. Odet Philippe, a French Count and surgeon in Napoleon's Navy, who established a plantation in the mid-1830s. In 1841, Fort Harrison was constructed on the bluffs overlooking what was then called Clearwater Harbor, serving as an encampment for soldiers. Upon the fort's abandonment, homesteaders began claiming land, with James Stevens being the first to obtain a land title in 1842, marking the beginning of Clearwater as a burgeoning community.

While Clearwater initially developed as an agricultural and fishing hub, it slowly expanded, with limited access to outside resources. The local springs, noted for their clear water, supplied Native Americans and early settlers with fresh water, contributing to the area's identity. Clearwater Harbor was officially incorporated in 1891 and became chartered as a municipality on May 27, 1915.










DUNEDIN


The establishment of Dunedin began with Richard L. Garrison receiving a land grant in 1852, shortly after Florida's statehood. The settlement initially bore Jonesboro, influenced by local merchant George Jones. It wasn't until 1882 that Scottish merchants J.O. Douglas and James Somerville petitioned for a name change to Dunedin, which they derived from the Scottish Gaelic term for Edinburgh.

Dunedin developed as a key trading center, thanks to a newly built dock that accommodated larger vessels, and once boasted the largest fleet of sailing vessels in Florida. The community was officially incorporated in 1899 and later elevated to city status in 1925.



INDIAN ROCKS

The name Indian Rocks is associated with local legends involving Chief Chic-a-Si, who was said to have been healed by spring waters near large rocks in the area. According to the legend, after drinking from these waters, the chief regained his health, leading Native Americans to return annually for healing and fishing. Another, simpler tale posits that early settlers named the area after observing Native Americans using rocky outcrops to cross from the mainland to fish. While the true origin of the name remains uncertain, both stories enrich the cultural tapestry of Indian Rocks Beach.



LARGO

Originally inhabited by the Timucua Indians, the area that would become Largo saw significant change following the arrival of Spanish explorers like Panfilo de Narvaez in 1528. After centuries of failed attempts at settlement by various explorers, Count Odet Philippe became the first permanent settler in the region in 1823, paving the way for subsequent families throughout the 1800s.

In 1886, with the advent of the Orange Belt Railroad, residents felt the need to give their



community a name. Although some proposed Luluville after a resident's daughter, they ultimately chose Largo, likely due to the presence of a large lake that has since been drained. By the early 1900s, Largo emerged as a center for the citrus industry, earning the title "Citrus City."

Largo was officially incorporated in 1905, becoming the first town in Florida to adopt a town manager system by 1913. Over decades, it faced challenges, including the Great Depression and freezes that devastated its agricultural base. However, post-World War II saw a population boom as returning veterans discovered the region's appeal, transforming Largo into a thriving city with a population exceeding 22,000 by 1970.

These historical narratives of Clearwater, Dunedin, Indian Rocks, and Largo reflect the rich tapestry and resilience of the local communities throughout Pinellas County, each contributing uniquely to the region's legacy.

beaches

There is no doubt that the Gulf Coast has some of the best beaches anywhere in the world; in fact, Clearwater Beach has been ranked by Dr. Beach as the number-one beach in the world many years running. There is never a loss of

things to do in Clearwater. If you're looking for an adventurous happening place where all the tourists go, then this beach is your pick. However, there are so many beautiful beaches in the area each offering its own style; you might want to check out where the locals soak up the sun.



Indian Shores / Tiki Gardens

This public-access beach is situated on 9.9 acres and offers restrooms, beach showers, a water fountain, and a 170-space parking area (parking fee charged).

Clearwater Beach

Clearwater Beach is one of the most beautiful (and most popular) beaches in the country. In fact, it's consistently ranked as one of the top beaches in the U.S. by authorities like TripAdvisor and Travel and Leisure. And it's no surprise why – the wide, sweeping, white-sand beach is absolutely stunning. And the warm, calm waters of the Gulf of Mexico are just unbeatable.

Caladesi Island State Park

This beautiful state park is located just off offshore from Dunedin and can be accessed by ferry, which operates 365 days a year and only costs \$6 per person (well worth the cost).

Caladesi Island State Park has a marina with floating docks with 30-amp electric service and water hookups. A covered pavilion with a grill is available for picnicking. A snack bar and gift shop are located in the marina. Some of the amenities include fishing, hiking, paddle boarding, picnicking, and swimming. Canoes and kayaks are available for rent.

1 Causeway Blvd, Dunedin, FL 34698 (727) 469-5918(ferry) While all of the tourists are stacked deep at Clearwater Beach, most locals head for the white sandy dunes of Indians Rocks Beach, where there are usually very few people on the beach, and you'll be able to spread out and enjoy a peaceful relaxing experience. After a long day at the beach, head to the original Crabby Bills on Gulf Boulevard at Fourth Avenue North for a premium adult beverage and a dozen fresh succulent oysters to start. Sit back and relax while listening to live music at their outdoor bar where a full menu is available for dinner.

Honeymoon Island Beach State Park

One of Florida's best-loved state parks, Honeymoon Island has more than four miles of beach to explore along with a three-mile trail through one of the last remaining virgin slash pine forests. A natural barrier island, this state park boasts pristine nature trails and abundant wildlife, including eagles, osprey, and great horned owls. Ground animals include raccoons, armadillos, and don't be surprised to see an endangered gopher tortoise walking across your path or hear the call of an osprey—or the bark of Fido, who may explore the dog beach, which is a half-mile hike off the main road. The Pinellas Trail has a spur that runs the length of the Dunedin Causeway right to the park entrance.

John S. Taylor Park

Taylor Park consists of 156.5 acres, including a 53-acre freshwater lake. Discover the sport of disc golf on a course set in the natural beauty of this park that also hosts a tree-lined 1.8-mile multi-purpose shell trail.

Amenities include a ball field, boat ramp (non-motorized), disc golf, fishing, picnic area, playground equipment, restrooms, seven picnic shelters with grills, and is located on the Pinellas Trail.

Eagle Lake Park

Great care was given to the restoration of the land's natural habitat during the park's development. One key feature is a wetlands section on the western side of the park, which has been restored with 100-percent native plants. The park is home to fox squirrels, numerous bird species, gopher tortoises, and water turtles.

Amenities include six picnic shelters, three restrooms, playground, dog park, a paved 12-foot wide recreation trail, numerous shell paths for walking and enjoying nature, 2,000 feet of boardwalks over restored wetlands, fishing, three vending stations 1800 Keene Rd., Largo, FL 33771

Largo Central Park Nature Preserve

Largo Central Park Nature Preserve (LCPNP) is a 31-acre nature park virtually surrounded by water. The park is home to hundreds of wildlife species for viewing. Over 130 species of birds, otters, red fox, American alligator, marsh rabbits, wild turkey, and bats all feed or live within the park. A 5-mile kayak/canoe route begins at the park and ends at Park Boulevard. Due to environmental reasons fishing is not allowed at the park. Dogs are not allowed.

John R. Bonner Nature Park

This park is Largo's best-kept secret! Bonner Park is on the Great Florida Birding Trail because of its diverse migratory bird population. Bonner Park features picnic facilities, nature trails, a playground, and a covered pavilion. This beautiful park overlooks the waterway. 14444 143rd St. N., Largo, FL 33774



Sand Key Beach State Park


This beautiful park has two distinct areas—a beach and a park. In the park proper are two picnic shelters with grills, a playground, a restroom, and a dog park. Grills, picnic tables, and water fountains are but a few amenities.

A salt marsh with viewing benches further enhances the park where heron, roseate spoonbill, great horned owl, anhinga, and common moorhen nest and feed.

Sand Key Park houses the base of operations for the artificial reef program, an interdepartmental cooperation program to build a reef in the Gulf. Sand Key Park's natural communities include a beach where sea turtles annually deposit eggs.

Amenities include a concession booth, boardwalk, nature trail, two beach wheelchairs, outdoor showers, two bathhouses with separate changing stalls and restrooms, parking (fee charged), dog park, playground, restrooms, two shelters with grills, umbrella and cabana rentals as well as kayak and bicycle rentals.



► CLEARWATER MARINE AQUARIUM

Clearwater Marine
Aquarium is a nonprofit
organization and
aquarium in Clearwater.
It is dedicated to the
rescue, rehabilitation,
and release of sick and
injured marine animals,
public education, conservation, and research.

Clearwater Marine Aquarium opened in 1972 at its current location on Clearwater Beach, in a former water treatment plant (the large pools being well-suited for rehabilitation operations).

Numerous forms of marine life are permanent residents at the aquarium, all of which have serious injuries that prevent their return to the wild.

The aquarium's best-known permanent resident was Winter, a bottlenose dolphin who was rescued in December 2005 after having her tail caught in a crab trap. Her injuries caused the loss of her tail, and the aquarium fitted her with a prosthetic tail, which brought worldwide attention to the facility. Winter later starred in the 2011 film *Dolphin Tale*, and the sequel, *Dolphin Tale* 2, was shot partially on location at the aquarium. Unfortunately, in November of 2021, Winter passed away, but her legacy lives on at the aquarium, where visitors can view her memorabilia, including her iconic prosthetic tail and memorabilia from her movies that honor her remarkable life and the inspiration she brought to millions.

► PINELLAS COUNTY TRAIL

The Fred Marquis Pinellas Trail is a rail-trail that stretches from Tarpon Springs in the north to St.

Petersburg in the south, passing through the towns of Palm Harbor, Dunedin, Belleair, Clearwater, Largo, Seminole, South Pasadena, and Gulfport. The Trail, created along a portion of an abandoned railroad corridor is a multi-use trail everyone can enjoy. It provides a unique, protected greenspace for walking, jogging, skating, and biking, and skating. Some trail users are able to commute to work using the Pinellas Trail instead of a motor vehicle. The distance that the main trail currently covers is 47 miles. The Pinellas Trail was named after Fred Marquis, a former Pinellas County Administrator who served from 1979 until 2000.

As a newcomer to Pinellas County,
Florida, it's important to be aware of
the beautiful wildlife that shares the area
with humans. One of the most fascinating events
that takes place on the county's beaches is sea turtle
nesting. Sea turtle nesting season typically runs from
May through October, with the peak of activity occurring
in July and August.

During this time, female sea turtles come ashore to lay their eggs in the sand, where they incubate for about two months before the hatchlings emerge and make their way to the sea. It's important to be mindful of sea turtle nesting areas and to take precautions to keep them safe.





HERE ARE SOME TIPS TO KEEP IN MIND WHEN VISITING THE BEACHES DURING NESTING SEASON:

- Respect the marked nesting areas Do not disturb any area that's marked as a nesting site. These areas are carefully monitored to ensure the safety of the eggs and hatchlings.
- 2. Avoid using lights on the beach at night Sea turtles are easily disoriented by artificial lights, which can cause them to lose their way and become prey to predators. It's best to avoid the use of flashlights and other lighting sources during nesting season.
- 3. Don't leave trash on the beach Trash and debris can be dangerous to sea turtles, who can become entangled and injured. Always dispose of trash and litter in proper receptacles.
- 4. Follow beach regulations Many beaches have specific regulations regarding behavior on the beach, such as no pets or no vehicles.

Make sure to follow these regulations to ensure the safety of the sea turtles. By following these tips, newcomers to Pinellas County can help protect the sea turtles that make their home on the beautiful beaches of this area. Remember, these stunning creatures are an important part of our ecosystem and deserve our respect and protection.
